



Park Patrol Captain (North/South)

Job Title: Park Patrol Captain

This position is part-time seasonal. Work hours vary Monday through Sunday, May – September, including holidays, and additional hours may be available beyond the summer season.

Job Description: Park Patrol Captains assist in the management of park patrol staff and serve as leaders within the park patrol team. Park Patrol provides a safe environment in Stroud Region parks and facilities. Staff enforces the regional park & facility rules and provides information on upcoming programs and special events. Maintains a safe and clean park.

This position requires lifting 25 pounds or more, sitting, standing, and walking outdoors (in different weather conditions) for multiple hours. Park Patrol operates municipal vehicles to assist with performing job duties; must maintain a valid driver's license. Bike patrol staff will need to be able to operate a mountain bike in different terrains and weather conditions.

This position is exempt and not eligible for overtime. Park Patrol staff reports to and is accountable to the Park Stewardship Supervisor.

Work Activities:

- Sets an example for positive relationships with the community and park users
- Patrols parks, facilities, and SROSRC programs/events either on foot or by bicycle
- Assists with supervision of north or south (as assigned) region of Stroud Greenway & regional parks; serves as manager on duty in the absence of Park Stewardship Manager
- Enforces all regional park and facility rules, regulations, and procedures
- Monitors weekly staff schedules and makes adjustments as needed with Park Stewardship Manager
- Assist with staff orientation and trainings
- Diffuses escalating situations
- Maintains the safety and cleanliness in our parks and facilities
- Collects park user fees and completes necessary forms in applicable parks
- Responds to an emergency situation when necessary; Coordinates with the Stroud Area Regional Police Department and local EMS as needed
- Communicates maintenance needs to the Park Stewardship Manager
- Work hours are assigned by the Park Stewardship Manager; must be punctual and dressed appropriately (staff shirt provided)
- Must be able to work May through September; additional hours may be available
- Completes tasks as assigned by the Park Stewardship Manager
- Works well with others and is respectful to participants, coworkers, and managers
- Complies with Commission rules and policies
